# INCOMING CLASS OF 2025



Each year, Point Foundation receives thousands of applications. Selecting scholarship recipients is a challenging but rewarding process. As the number of scholarships Point Foundation offers continues to grow, we find ourselves continually inspired by our applicants' remarkable achievements and dedication to making a positive impact on the world.


Point is proud to announce that we are supporting 1,000 Point Scholars in the 2025-2026 academic year. This milestone not only reflects our commitment to empowering LGBTQ+ and ally leaders, but also underscores the remarkable potential burning bright within the next generation.

**This year, we introduced three new programs:**

- **The Point Access Scholarship** is for students who are either first-generation college students or from low-income households.
- **The Internship & Professional Development Award** supports LGBTQ+ and ally students as they pursue summer academic enrichment opportunities.
- **The Kadel and Gerhardt Internships** support students addressing HIV/AIDS in their summer academic programs.

In 2025, we're supporting Point Scholars from all 50 states, Washington, DC, and Canada. They are pursuing over 300 different majors and have plans to become lawyers, doctors, financial advisors, nurses, social workers, AI engineers, bankers, actors, corporate leaders, and more. Through their work both in their careers and as community members, these LGBTQ+ and ally students will shape the future for the better.

# NAMED SCHOLARSHIPS

Point Foundation's scholarship program allows individuals, organizations, foundations, and corporations to establish a scholarship in honor of an individual or organization.

A lasting impact comes from endowing a scholarship in perpetuity with a \$500,000 contribution. Such a gift makes it possible for Point to finance the education of scholars today and far into the future.

Donors can also support Point's Community College Program by creating scholarships through a gift of \$8,000 per student per year.

These scholarships help cover tuition, Point programming, and help defray other costs associated with attending community college.

In 2024, Point further expanded its support of Persistence Scholarships which provide another opportunity for postsecondary students in need to receive financial assistance and career development programming, helping them to overcome barriers to education and fostering their growth.

# NATIONAL LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE



The National Leadership Conference (NLC) strengthened Flagship Scholars' connection to the Point Foundation community and centered conversations on leadership and advocacy under the theme Capitalize the Moment: LGBTQ+ Leadership for Today & Tomorrow.

Held July 18–21, 2024, in Washington, D.C., the conference brought together scholars, board members, alumni, staff, and corporate partners. Workshops and networking sessions connected Scholars with leaders across education, corporate, nonprofit, legal, and political sectors.


Throughout the program, Scholars expanded their professional networks, gained new insights, and explored how Point's leadership pillars—purpose, superpowers, champions, and wellness—can guide their personal and professional growth.

A highlight of the NLC was a keynote by Point Alum Alexia Korberg, who underscored the importance of civic engagement and LGBTQ+ advocacy. Attendees examined the history of key legislation and recent court decisions ahead of an interactive U.S. Capitol tour, deepening their understanding of policymaking and the urgency of elevating LGBTQ+ and ally voices in these spaces.

# NEW SCHOLAR ORIENTATION



In July, Point hosted our New Scholar Orientation, a transformative experience designed to introduce our newest students to Point's extensive resources and vibrant community.

In addition to workshops and opportunities to connect with one another, attendees privately toured the ONE Archives, which is the world's largest repository of LGBTQ+ materials and history. Established in 1952, it collects, preserves, and provides access to a wide range of documents, photographs, and artifacts that chronicle the LGBTQ+ experience, activism, and culture.

For many Point Scholars, the New Scholar Orientation offered them a chance to be seen for their full selves, beyond just their grades and achievements. Point Foundation's holistic approach ensures our students are supported in every aspect of their lives and provides a sense of belonging and support that will go on to fuel their commitment to give back, uplift others, and create positive change.

At the conclusion of the New Scholar Orientation, the newest Point Scholars left equipped with connections, resources, and a sense of purpose: education as a pathway to transformation. With Point's support, their potential is illuminated, and their future is full of promise.



# CAREER DISCOVERY DAYS

In Spring 2025, Point Foundation held a two-day in-person Discovery Days event for ten Point Scholars in New York City. This programming is part of Point's commitment to career education and exposure for our students, helping them thrive as leaders post-college. Scholars were selected based on their interest in pursuing careers in the finance sector and participated in two full days at Apollo Global Management and Wells Fargo. In November, Wells Fargo scholars were invited to an additional career exposure visit to learn about the company and pathways to careers in the financial sector.

At Wells Fargo, students were treated to a presentation of the company's history, which highlighted their longstanding commitment to the communities they serve, including being one of the first corporations to support LGBTQ+ causes. Participants also toured the Wells Fargo trading floor, gaining a tangible sense of the fast-paced environment of investment banking.


The following day at Apollo Global Management, students heard from Apollo leaders in various departments, including recruitment, technology and engineering, risk management, and impact investing—who went in depth to give students a robust picture of what their roles entail and how they got there.

One Point Scholar shared, “I appreciated Apollo’s emphasis on innovation, long-term thinking, and how they align their investments with sustainability and impact. A major takeaway for me was how important it is to be intellectually curious, adaptable, and willing to step outside your comfort zone in this fast-paced industry.”



Another Point Scholar said that at Wells Fargo, “many speakers highlighted the importance of being authentic and following one’s passion.”

The impact was clear: survey results showed that our scholars gained confidence in their career goals, networking, and job-search skills. Plus, students are left with a deeper understanding of career pathways in finance, practical tools for professional growth, and expanded networks that will support their journeys ahead.


